## QUESTIONS/ANSWERS FOR RFP –SPECIALIZED SPECIALTY BUSINESS COACH

- 1. Can the Cherokee Nation advise if there are special licenses or requirements for non-indian and or out of state businesses that wish to respond to this request for proposal? Don't know of anything specific that would be required.
- **2.** Can the Cherokee Nation provide further detail on the source and amount of funding received for this project?
  - Specifically, is there a defined budget for the project? This funding is made available through the ARPA funding.
- **3.** Would the Cherokee Nation evaluators like a price proposal based on hourly costs, not to exceed maximums, or line item breakdown? **Yes, hourly costs not to exceed would be preferred.**
- **4.** Is the Cherokee Nation open to receiving coaching services from small businesses through a virtual or hybrid format? **In person coaching would be preferred, however, if the small business client is willing, a hybrid format would be acceptable for some clients.**
- 5. How many small business or small business owners are expected to participate? We anticipate 100 small business will participate.
- 6. Is there an estimated amount of total monthly hours or service obligations that the Cherokee Nation expects? This would depend on the number of clients the specialized coach would be able to accept. Commerce Services is

willing to work with each coach to maximize their time and ability to work with the clients.

7. Is there a projected amount of time estimated for the person/party that wins either proposals? For instance, some programs that I have been commissioned for require a full 40 hours a week. Other programs have only required 2 days a week at an 8 hour working day. The time estimated will depend on the client. Each Specialized coach will work with the client to come up with and estimated number of hours. I would estimate that each client would be 5-10 hours per week at the start and then taper off as the work begins.
