PROJECT SUMMARY

The Cherokee Nation is seeking sealed bids from qualified contractors to provide all materials, equipment, manpower, oversight and supervision to complete a walking trail at a site located in Tahlequah, Oklahoma (Cherokee County). The Cherokee Nation will only be accepting sealed bids from General Contracting Companies to act as the sole primary Contractor. Interested parties are to provide bids to furnish all labor, quality control, materials, supplies, and supervision to complete the project. All bids from General Contractors shall be whole and assume all sub-contracts and divisions of labor. The Nation will be accepting sealed bids from Indian and Non-Indian parties. Indian preference will be given only to responding parties who provide proof of current certification from the Cherokee Nation Tribal Employments Office (TERO) located in Tahlequah, Oklahoma, telephone number (918) 453-5000. Indian preference will be applied in accordance with current TERO legislation and the Nation's Policy and Procedures. Proof of TERO certification must accompany and be included in bid submittal along with all other mandatory documents.

- <u>August 13, 2024 by 2:00 pm CT</u> Sealed bids are due. A Public Bid Opening will be held August 13, 2024 at 2:00 p.m. in the Financial Resources Large Conference Room (directly behind the Main Complex), 17665 S. Muskogee, Tahlequah, Oklahoma. Only parties attending the mandatory site visit will be considered eligible for award.

Indian Preference will apply to the entire project. To receive Indian Preference a copy of the Cherokee Nation TERO Certificate (front and back) must be included with the sealed bid. The TERO representative will provide more information on the TERO fees and permits necessary for this this project.

A bid bond must be included with the sealed bid submittal. The successful party will be required to provide a Payment Bond and a Performance Bond. Bond requirement information is stated on pages 44 and 45 of the RFB Packet.

Insurance Requirements for this project are on pages 46 and 47 of the RFB Packet.

The sealed bid must address all evaluation factors fully and include all mandatory response documents.

Mandatory Documents to be included in the sealed bid are listed on page 6 section "C" and also listed on the Preparation Outline, Attachment A, of the RFB Packet.
